SCSEP participants are placed into subsidized employment in a non-profit Host Agency for 20 hours per week. SCSEP program provides wages, training and job search assistance.

#### Benefits to non-profit agencies (Host Agencies):

Think of SCSEP as an employment agency. We recruit, screen and match older workers with the needs of your agency.

#### There are no fees to your agency!

SCSEP pays wages and fringe benefits to the Participants.
