- What Phase of the Distribution plan do ASAP/AAA frontline/consumer facing STAFF fall under?
- What Phase of the Distribution plan do ASAP/AAA frontline/consumer facing VOLUNTEERS fall under?
- What Phase of the Distribution plan do Elder Congregate Housing residents and staff fall under
- What Phase of the Distribution plan do Elder Supportive Housing residents and staff fall under?
- What Phase of the Distribution plan do Adult Day Health and Supportive Day program consumers and staff fall under?
- What Phase of the Distribution plan do Adult Foster Care program consumers and staff fall under?
- Can you confirm that frontline Homemakers, Personal Care Homemakers, Chore workers, and Companions are included in the definition of “home-based” and home health workers prioritized under Phase 1 of the Distribution plan?
- What kind of documentation will individuals who work in HCBS settings (ie. home care workers, PCAs, frontline ASAP staff and volunteers) be required to provide at Vaccine distribution sites to "prove" that they fall within a certain priority group?
- What Phase of the Distribution plan will administrative staff at ASAPs/AAAs/Home Care Agencies fall under?
- What is the state’s plan for vaccinating homebound older adults and individuals who live in community and cannot easily access vaccination sites?

- Will the public outreach be targeted to specific populations (such as older adults, frontline direct care workers, tec.)? Will there be a media/PR kit available for community-based organizations to distribute?
